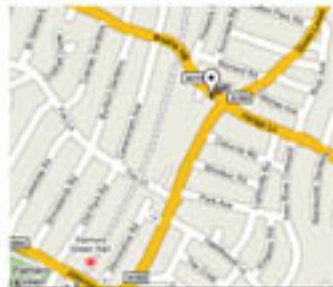

OTHER GROUPS

YPTC - GET SET - Ages 13-16

Palmers Green - Fridays 5-9pm £12 per week
Camden - Saturdays 9am-12pm £11 per week

Get Set is a foundation level training in all aspects of the performing arts for young people who are thinking about a career in performance.

JUNIOR YPTC - Ages 16-20

Camden - Saturdays 11.30-6.30 - £18 per week

JYPTC is a professional level course leading towards showcase performances and theatre and film projects.

YPTC One & Two Year Courses - Ages 19-25

Camden - Saturdays 11am-6pm - £18 per week

These courses prepare students for a career in performance with showcases, theatre productions, filmed showreels and membership of the YPTC Agency.

YPTC Workshops - Ages 19-25

Camden - Saturdays 10.30-3.30 - £18 per week

The workshops run from January-July and are designed to help students develop their skills and experience YPTC classes before committing to a full course. Acceptance onto the YPTC courses are dependent on successful completion of workshops.
